## Magic Cast On

This is my slip-knot free version of Judy's Magic Cast-On, a provisional cast-on great for starting toe-up socks and more.

You can use two circular needles, or two double-pointed needles (dpns), as I did here.
























5. Move both needles over yarn on index finger, then move Needle 2 under and up on the other side, wrapping yarn over it and down between the two needles.



7. Repeat steps 3 to 6 until you have the desired number of stitches on each needle, making sure there are the same number on each.



9. On the back of your cast-on round, you should see little purl bumps.
